ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA










- Maximum 2 entries per college.
- It is a team event. A team can have **4-6 members**, preferably an even number of males and females. (Including participants, choreographer, and coordinator).
- The time limit for every team would be different for both the days. (Including setup and performance both)
- There shall be negative marking if participants exceed the time limit.
- The themes for both the days are mentioned below.
- A green room would be provided for the changing purpose.
- The teams should carry their tracks in a pen drive and should be submitted in advance.
- Vulgarity is strongly prohibited. Any form of obscenity will lead to debarring the team from the contest.
 Hence, if the team feels that any stunt or costume design can be considered vulgar, it is strongly advised to consult the organizers. The decision of the organizers will be final in case of any disputes.
- The use of cigarettes, alcohol, and any unfair means is strongly prohibited.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- During the final rounds, the panel will be open to ask questions from teams.
- Teams have to bring their own props. All props used by the teams must be cleared from the stage immediately after the performances and from the college premises at the end of the event. Use of flammable substances or any substance that would otherwise dirty the stage so as to render its subsequent usage inconvenient or impossible is strictly prohibited.
- The organizing committee has the right to make any changes in the schedule, venue, or guidelines if circumstances demand.
- The competition will be conducted in two rounds, details of which are mentioned below.

EVENT STRUCTURE



·QUALIFIERS

Day 1 (2nd February, 2024)

Competitors will be required to perform a ramp walk for the judge. The ramp walk and costume of the contestants would be evaluated. The shortlisted participants will move to the final round.

Time allotted - 6 minutes per team {including 2 minutes for setup and 4 minutes for performance}

Theme - Neon & Gothic

·FINALS


Day 3 - 4th February, 2024

This will be an interactive round where the judges will interact and ask questions to the participants.

Participants will be asked to present to the judges their idea behind the costume design, and its relevance to the theme. The questions would be based on their costume, and general questions to understand the participant.

Time allotted – **10 minutes per team** {including 3 minutes for setup and 7 minutes for the performance}

Theme - 5 Elements of Earth



JUDGEMENT CRITERIA

Choreography (10 points):

- Presentation of clothing sequences: 4 points
- Transitions between outfits: 3 points
- Creative use of movement or positioning on the runway: 3 points

Music (10 points):

- Suitability to the fashion theme and mood: 4 points
- Enhancing the overall runway experience: 3 points
- Coherence with the pacing of the fashion presentation: 3 points

Coordination (15 points):

- Synchronization and timing of models: 6 points
- Consistency in pacing throughout the show: 5 points
- Group dynamics and interaction among models: 4 points

Adherence to and Depiction of the Theme Provided (20 points):

- Clarity in conveying the theme through clothing: 8 points
- Innovation and creativity in interpreting the theme: 7 points
- Consistency in maintaining the theme across different outfits: 5 points

Creative and Apt Display of Garments and Accessories (20 points):

- Originality in fashion design and accessory choices: 8 points
- Relevance and appropriateness to the theme: 7 points
- Overall visual impact and enhancement of the fashion presentation: 5 points


Walk of Each Participant (15 points):

- Confidence and style in the runway walk: 6 points
- Alignment with the overall theme and fashion style: 5 points
- Attention to posture and presentation: 4 points

Overall Impact of the Performance (10 points):

- Memorable moments or standout fashion pieces: 4 points
- Cohesiveness and completeness of the fashion presentation: 3 points
- Audience engagement and reaction: 3 points


ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Be aware that any fluids, flames, powders, glitters, heavy or sharp objects or any sort of materials having the potential to damage or tamper the stage is not entertained.
- We maintain a strong commitment to maintaining a respectful and appropriate environment. Any use of vulgarity or obscenity is strictly prohibited and may result in immediate disqualification. We kindly request that participants select songs accordingly.
- The organising committee reserves the right to take appropriate action for any unethical, unprofessional, immoral conduct and uncalled behaviour of the participants at the competition venue.
- The organising committee reserves the right to vary, alter, modify and or repeal any provision of the rules if so required. In any situation which is contemplated by the rules, the decision of the organising committee shall remain final and binding.

- Overall technical prowess and mastery: 3 points







Note: The judges' decision is irrevocable, emphasizing the importance of fairness and impartiality in the evaluation process.



- Maximum of 2 teams per college.
- Volunteers will help to assist the equipments and soundcheck process.
- No pre-recorded tracks or sequences will be permitted.
- A team is allowed to bring their own sound engineer who may work for their band and their band only.
- Backing tracks are not allowed during live performance.
- Any band found to be in violation of these rules will be disqualified from the competition.
- All bands must conduct themselves in a professional manner throughout the competition.
- Any band found to be engaging in unsportsmanlike conduct will be disqualified.
- A strict penalty will be imposed for exceeding time limit.
- Each band can perform for a maximum performance time of 10 minutes (3 minutes for setup and 7 minutes for performance).
- Bands must arrange their own instruments and equipment except drums.
- All bands can perform songs across genres.
- There is no restriction on the number of songs a team can perform if the time limit is adhered to.
- The stage will be equipped with connections sufficient to cater to a maximum seven-piece band (2 vocal microphones and standard drum kit).


To participate, individuals must be bonafide students currently enrolled in both undergraduate and postgraduate programs at recognized universities. Participants must carry their college identity cards.

- Originality of the script is essential. **Deadline for submission of script is January 30, 2024**.

- Participants to be respectful of the audience and public space, including not disrupting or blocking passersby.
- Participants should be responsible for script development and thorough rehearsals, ensuring smooth execution during the competition. Maintain guidelines for language and content to ensure performances are respectful and appropriate for all audiences.




- The event will be conducted in **ONLINE MODE**.


- The **theme/topic** will be intimidated to the participant **via mail on February 2nd, 2024.**







ABOUT THE EVENT



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA


To participate, individuals must be bonafide students currently enrolled in both undergraduate and postgraduate programs at recognized universities. Participants must carry their college identity cards.



- This is an individual or a dual event. People can also participate in pairs.
- Each participant will be given a set time limit for their performance, i.e. 5 minutes for the act and 2 minutes for preparation, in total 7 minutes. Going over the allocated time may result in point deductions or disqualification.
- Comedians must create their jokes and content on the spot during their performance. Any use of pre-written material will result in disqualification.
- Comedians are encouraged to engage with the audience, but they must do so respectfully. Offensive or inappropriate content will not be tolerated.
- Performers should rely solely on their wit and verbal skills. The use of props or costumes is not allowed.
- To ensure spontaneity, comedians may be given random topics. The performers must incorporate these suggestions into their act.
- Any form of cheating, plagiarism, or attempts to manipulate the competition will result in immediate disqualification.
- Comedians should maintain a supportive and respectful environment backstage. Any disruptive behavior towards fellow contestants may result in penalties.
- All material must adhere to appropriate content standards. Performers should be mindful of the audience's sensibilities, and any explicit or offensive content may lead to disqualification.
- The judges' decisions shall be final and binding
- Good sportsmanship is expected from all participants. Celebrate the joy of comedy and encourage your fellow comedians.
- The event organizers reserve the right to make changes to the rules or event format if necessary, with prior notice to all participants.



JUDGEMENT CRITERIA



1. Creativity (30 points)

- Originality of Jokes: How innovative and fresh are the participant's jokes? Judges will reward creativity that goes beyond common comedic tropes.
- Unique Perspectives: Participants who provide unique and unexpected perspectives on given topics or situations will receive higher scores.

2. Delivery (25 points):

- Timing: Judges will evaluate the participant's sense of timing, including pauses, pacing, and the overall rhythm of the performance.
- Confidence: The level of confidence displayed on stage, including body language, voice projection, and overall stage presence.

3. Audience Engagement (20 points):

- Interaction: How well does the participant engage with the audience? Judges will consider the ability to connect with the crowd through eye contact, responsiveness to audience reactions, and the incorporation of audience suggestions.
- Laughter Generation: Judges will assess the comedian's effectiveness in eliciting genuine laughter from the audience.

4. Adaptability (15 points):


- Handling Curveballs: The ability to adapt and incorporate these elements seamlessly into the act will be evaluated.
- Flexibility: Judges will consider how well the comedian adjusts to the flow of the event.

5. Overall Comedic Impact (10 points):

- Memorable Moments: Judges will assess whether the comedian creates memorable and impactful moments during their performance.
- Entertainment Value: The overall entertainment value of the act, including its ability to leave a lasting impression on the audience.

6. Bonus Points (Up to 5 points):

- Spontaneity: Judges may award bonus points for exceptional displays of quick thinking, wit, or improvised humor that goes above and beyond expectations.
- Crowd Reactions: Positive audience reactions, such as sustained laughter or applause, may contribute to bonus points.


